

Trinity Academy Graduate Scholarship 2008 Application Guidelines

This packet contains information on the Trinity Academy Graduate Scholarship. Friends of Trinity Academy provide scholarship funds through donations.

Purpose: The purpose of the Trinity Academy Graduate Scholarship is to recognize and support our alumni.

Students should read the entire packet thoroughly. Following is the criteria for application:

- The student must apply on the attached scholarship form.
- The student must have beyond a minimum C grade point average.
- The student must prepare an original essay including both of the following topics
 1. How has your Trinity education impacted your spiritual and intellectual growth?
 2. How has it strengthened your character and prepared you for your future?
- The student must be a senior at a high school or home school.
- The student must have attended and graduated from Trinity Academy.
- The student must plan to attend an institution of higher learning during the 2008/2009 school year.
- The winner must make every attempt to appear at the Trinity Academy graduation and briefly address the 5th grade students.
- Application must be received by the deadline.

Essay Requirements: Applicants are asked to write an essay in response to the questions as listed above. The original submittals must be:

1. One to four pages, double sided
2. Double spaced
3. Typed with 1 inch margins

Scholarship: The amount available for the scholarship varies from year to year, as it is dependent on the availability of funds. For the 2008/2009 academic year, the Selection Committee anticipates the award will be \$500.

Deadline: To be considered for the scholarship, the student must mail the application to the Selection Committee by **March 22, 2008**. The Selection Committee will make every effort to notify the winner no later than April 5th.

Selection of Winners:

- Application must meet all criteria as stated above
- The primary basis for selection of the scholarship winner is the original essay
- Scholastic achievement is not a factor in selection of the scholarship winner
- Financial need and extra-curricular or community activities are not factors in the scholarship selection process.

The Trinity Academy Graduate Scholarship Selection Committee consists of the School Advisory Board and the Trinity Academy Principal. The entries will be judged on content, originality, and form (grammar, spelling and punctuation). You must submit five copies of your paper with the application.
